This stands in contrast to other performance specialists which are after-market tuners. The Alpina B7 is produced at the same assembly line in Dingolfing, Germany (BMW Plant Dingolfing) as BMW's own 7 series. The B7's twin-turbo 4.4 liter V8 engine is hand assembled at Alpina's facility in Buchloe, Germany before being shipped to BMW for installation. The assembled vehicle is then sent back to Alpina for finishing touches.
